Since 1974, we have developed more than 1,500 affordable rental homes, created 2,074 first-time homeowners, prevented 1,532 foreclosures, and developed hundreds of resident leaders.

In 2021, we are completing a strategic plan that will create more opportunities for low to moderate-income (LMI) families to build wealth, redouble our efforts toward racial justice, and build even more affordable homes.

Responded strongly to the pandemic by launching our \$500,000 Roxbury/JP Resiliency Fund.




Built Wealth for families by helping to create 115 first-time LMI homeowners.
